### **Photo Submission Guidelines**

We use the same photo submission guidelines for our member review photo shows as CAPA requires for competition entries. Here they are:

- The image should have a maximum width of 1400 and a maximum height of 1050 pixels.
  - o If you are submitting a phone photo that has not been processed on a computer, send it by email as an attachment using an image size of "Large" for iPhone, if you've got an Android, send one size less than "Actual Size" (we're working on this).
- Name your image files with your name followed by a dash (-) followed by the theme keyword e.g. "Health" or "B&W" followed by a dash, and then the image title; e.g. "Bruce Pond-B&W-Guardians.jpg".
- Submit the images to Bruce Pond (<u>millpondsailor@gmail.com</u>) with the theme keyword in the subject line, e.g. Light Painting.
- If you wish your submission to be reviewed in our "Coaching Conversation," then please include the keyword "Coaching" in your email's subject line and text.
